Slipping on staples during ascent to platform

Preventative

Measures: Annual check by M.I.C. holder; weekly equipment/tree/wire checks
Comprehensive instructor training and assessment by M.I.C. holder
Helmets worn in proximity of zipwire
Bi-monthly check of anchor points and bolts
Belay system for ascent of tree
Third person always available to assist with rescue
Regular monitoring by Head of Activities
Strict adherence to M.I.C. recommendations

Miscellaneous: 1:8 ratio (instructor/children); 1:1 when on platform.
